Intel has also been expanding into new adjacencies, such as communications infrastructure, automotive, and the Internet of Things. Further, Intel expects to leverage its chip manufacturing capabilities into an outsourced foundry model where it constructs chips for others.

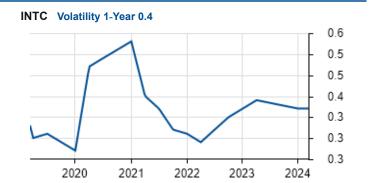

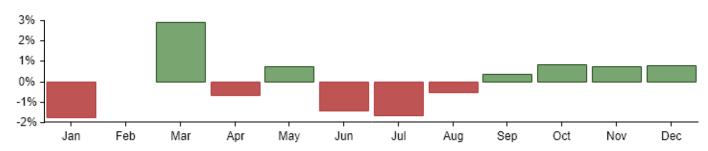

#### Seasonal Performance vs the S&P 500



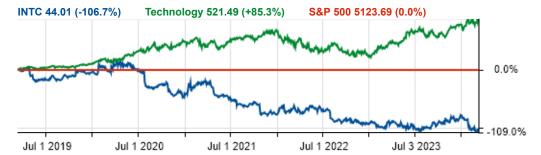
## 5-YEAR RELATIVE PERFORMANCE VS S&P 500

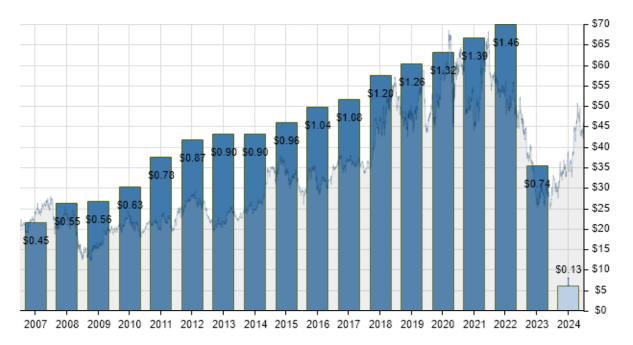
