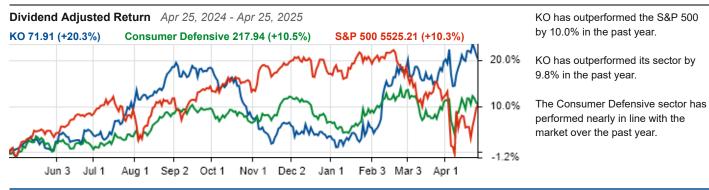

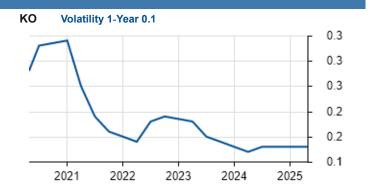

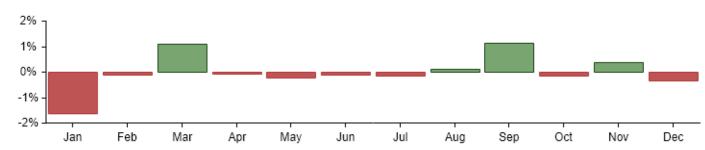

### Seasonal Performance vs the S&P 500

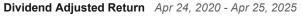


### 5-YEAR RELATIVE PERFORMANCE VS S&P 500
